

Homestead Exemption

Homestead Exemption may be filed from January 1st to April 1st. The following documents are needed when filing for homestead exemption.

- All deeds to your property (It has to be the recorded instrument – Warranty Deeds or quit-claims – **NOT** the Deed of Trust)
- Car tag numbers for all vehicles owned by you or in your possession (If you have tags other than Greene County, you must change them before you can file.)
- Social Security numbers for you, your spouse, and any joint owners.
- Birth dates for you, your spouse, and any joint owners.
- Purchase price of home.
- Amount of down payment or equity.
- Purchase price of land, if you purchased it separately from the home.
- If you built the home yourself, we need to know what it cost you to build it.
- If you live in a mobile home on your property, you must bring your mobile home registration certificate.
- If you are 65 years of age or older, you need to bring proof of age, such as a drivers license or birth certificate.
- If you are 100% disabled, you should inquire as to what you should do.
